O R D E R

The authority of Karbi Anglong Autonomous Council is pleased to settle the following Entry Tax Gates, markets, ghats, Fisheries & Cattle pounds for the period with effect from 1st April 2018 to 31st March 2019 with the bidders at the highest quoted rates against the names of Entry Tax Gates, markets, ghats, Fisheries & Cattle pounds under Diphu, Phuloni and Silonijan Revenue Circle on the following Terms & conditions.

1. The Lessees shall have to levy tolls at the prescribed rates under Section 6(a) & Section 6(b) Regulation No.1 of the Karbi Anglong District (Miscellaneous Taxes and Tolls) Regulation, 1983 and section 5(2) Act No. II of the Karbi Anglong Market (Management and control) Act, 1954 (Copy of prescribed rates enclosed)
2. The selected bidders shall have to deposit the settled amount in 1(one) installment within 15(fifteen) days from the date of issue of this settlement order, failing which this settlement shall stand cancelled automatically and the 2nd highest bidder will be settled at the highest bidder rate.
3. The selected bidders must deposit the settled amount in the form of Bank Draft/ Banker's cheque drawable in SBI Diphu or may be deposited in cash at Cash Branch, KAAC pledged in favour of the Deputy Secretary i/c Taxation, KAAC, Diphu.
4. The selected bidders shall produce council money Receipt to the office of the Superintendent of Taxes, KAAC, Diphu for obtaining collection order.
5. The Lessees must enter into Deed of Agreement on Non Judicial paper before the undersigned.
6. The selected bidders shall not be allowed to collect tax/tolls until the above condition are fulfilled.
7. The lessee shall not collect exorbitant rate other than prescribed rates under Section 6 (a) & Section 6(b) Regulation No.1 of the Karbi Anglong District (Miscellaneous Taxes and Tolls) Regulation, 1983 and under section 5(2) Act No. II of the Karbi Anglong Market (Management and control) Act, 1954.
8. The selected bidder shall be called " lessee" after signing of Deed of Agreement.
